

RedLine Athletics Summer Camp FAQ's:

STAFF:

Who will be training children during summer camp?

RedLine's Sport Performance Specialists (SPS) will lead camp activities each day.

What training do SPS's have?

Our SPS staff typically have or are working toward college degrees in kinesiology, sports performance, or physical therapy, and are trained and certified by RedLine on proper training procedures and methodologies. We also have CSCS (Certified Strength and Conditioning Specialists). Most of our staff played sports at the college and/or professional level.

What is the SPS-to-camper ratio?

There will be at least 1 SPS for every 4 campers.

Will the camp provide lunch/snacks for the children?

No, campers are asked to bring a water bottle and snacks if desired.

Has all of your staff passed a background check?

Yes, ALL staff has undergone background checks.

Are all staff trained in first aid?

Yes, all staff has been trained in first aid.

CAMPER EXPERIENCE:

What ages do you accept for summer camp?

8 – 18

Are your groups coed?

Yes, all group campers and staff are coed.

How will my child be placed in a group?

Campers are placed based on ability and age.

May I pack a snack for my camper? Where/when can they eat it?

Snacks may be brought to camp. A snack area will be designated for breaks.

What is your sickness policy?

A sick child is to be kept at home for his or her own sake and that of the other children and staff. Any child that demonstrates the signs of a fever (100.5° or greater) or illness will be sent home from camp. Please do not send your child back to camp until the symptoms of fever and/or contagious illness have been gone for 24 hours without the aid of medication.

HOW IT WORKS:

If I decide to join RedLine may I have the discounted camp rate retroactively?

Yes, the discount will be applied to your first month's membership and is capped at one month's value of membership.

How does your general camp pick up and drop off work?

Drop off will take place out front. A staff member will meet campers at the door for a quick drop off.

Pick up requires campers to be signed out.

Do you provide transportation to and from your camp?

Not at this time.
